

**Memorandum of Understanding**  
**between**  
**Zambridge Senanga Foundation in the Netherlands**  
**and**  
**the Local Board in Senanga, Zambia**

The Local Board of Zambridge Senanga Foundation, based in Senanga Zambia, can be considered to be the ‘bridge’ between Zambridge Senanga and the local community of Senanga. Keeping in mind that the Zambridge Senanga Foundation only supports the community and not individual persons, they will perform the following tasks for the Dutch Board of Zambridge:

- Receiving the funds for the supported groups in Senanga district and distributing them according to the instructions of the Chair or the Treasurer of the Dutch Board
- Monitoring the developments in the funded projects
- Informing and advising the Dutch Board about the developments in the funded projects
- Advising the local groups/organizations in Senanga on drafting applications and reports to the Dutch Board of Zambridge Senanga

The local board also has a ‘signal and control function’ which means that in cases of disagreement or conflict they will act as follows:

- If the project money is not spent as agreed, they will talk with the concerned group, trying to settle and come to an agreement which will be proposed to the Dutch Board.
- If there is a change of opinion about spending the fund, this will be communicated to the Dutch Board, together with an advise from the Local Board.
